



Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps eligible low-income families with home heating costs by partially paying the cost of your natural gas bill. Eligibility is based on your household income to ensure help goes to those most in need.

If you qualify, you could also benefit with:

- Weatherization Services
- Furnace Cleaning, Repair or Replacement
- Chimney Cleaning and Inspection
- Emergency Assistance

Heating Season Income Guidelines

Eligibility is based on a household's income to ensure help goes to those most in need. A household's income must be at or below 60 percent of North Dakota's median income and within these limits:

Both homeowner and renter households are eligible for the program. Individual tribal LIHEAP programs serve tribal members living on reservations in the state.
